

USJN Premier Midwest
Day 1&2 Recap
July 5-6 Cincinnati, OH



IGBRR kicked off the first week of July exposure in Cincinnati for the 12th annual USJN Premier Midwest. We spent two days at the event and were able to view 16 of the nearly 30 Indiana teams from 9 programs that took the floor. The four day event eventually crowned one Indiana division champ, **Sky Diggs 17U Sullivan** and 27 Indiana pool all-stars, including **2016 G A.Van Dyke, Westfield**, of the Sky Diggs championship team. Following are a few kids that had standout performances to kick-off the viewing period in the contest we were able to attend.

Pool B- **Sky Diggs 17U Gold**- 4-1 Pool Runner-up. Experienced team that is always playing at the highest levels in the National pools. 2016 6'1 W/F **H.Reinoehl, Westfield**, continues to impress with her versatile play. Long with nice wingspan and is growing her game on the offensive end. Knockdown mid-range jumper and is using length to finish opportunities around the basket. Multiple D1 offers in hand. 2016 **K.O'Reilly, Noblesville**, athletic forward that has tremendous hops and uses that to be effective around the basket on both ends. High motor kid that plays physical and has extended game to wing some as she improves off the bounce. Multiple D1 offers in hand

Pool C- **Indiana Flight Strike** – One of the more talented “young” teams in the state, young but normally playing in National level pools. Led by IGBRR#1 2018 PG **K.Traylor, Martinsville**. Not much to say that hasn't already.. explosive lefty guard that is being recruited by and has offers from some of the top programs in the country. 2018 5'11 F **S.Hill, Perry Meridan**, has huge upside potential. You can usually find her using her athleticism around the rim on both ends but has demonstrated she has skills that translate to the wing as well. She has also started to process the play at the elite level better translating into more consistent decisions with the ball.

Pool D- **MBA Select 17U**- Strong collection of both Indiana & Michigan 2016 players. 2016 PG **M.Grewe, Mishawaka**, heady point that does a good job of valuing possessions and making the correct decisions with the ball. Very solid fundamentals and true point.

Pool E- **Indiana Elite/Team Indiana** – 2017 6'3 big body post **J.Williams, Southport**, was a guest player but was not shy about asserting herself in the paint. Williams was explosive in her post moves and demonstrated quick feet for her size. 2018 PG **L.Leal, Bloomington South**, smooth lefty point guard with plenty of skill. Good job of running the offense, getting out in transition and seeing the floor, demonstrated capable jumper as well.

Pool F – **Indy Magic Blanding** – 5-0 Pool winners. 2017 **M. Wise, Greenfield Central**, versatile 6’0 W that does good things with her length and athleticism around the basket but very comfortable and capable of handling the ball on the wing and in the open floor. Rebounds the ball well and is special in the transition game. She has multiple D1 offers in hand.

Pool I – **Sky Diggs 17U Sullivan-** 5-0 pool winners, bracket champions. The lone Indiana team to come away with a division USJN Championship. 2016 **A.Van Dyke, Westfield**, once known as a shooter has become a versatile scorer. She was putting it on the floor going towards the rim with authority and posting up smaller mismatches. Strong frame with plenty of upside. D1 one offers in hand. 2017 **D.Sullivan, South Bend St Joe**, is a well-known commodity. Strong true point that sees the floor, makes good decisions with the ball and very capable of scoring as she demonstrated with her 32pt performance in the championship game. 2017 6’1 C/F **M.Williams, Fountain Central**, may have one of the highest climbing stocks this club season. Big strong frame with massive wing span that comes with soft hands and good feet. Rebounds the ball well, runs the floor and agile for size.

Pool N- Flight Duke – 2017 F/W **K.Hopkins, Avon**, showed a lot of versatility on the offensive end. Shot it well from behind the arch while also operating physically with the ball in close quarters around the rim. She was active without the ball as well. defending, communicating and rebounding. 2017 6'2 C **L.Bode, Avon**, big strong post frame & runs the floor well, defends and rebounds. Is still finding her way offensively but improving.

Pool S – MBA Select 15U – 5-0 Pool winners. There are several 2017s in this group to like. 17' F/W 5'10 **H.Dunn, Tippy Valley**, is a workhorse around the basket yet skilled enough to step out and play the wing. Can defend multiple positions and stays active and physical on both ends. 17' 5'7 CG **C.Dunlap, Argos**, skilled and athletic multi sport prospect. Very smooth with the ball, with nice instincts for the game on both ends.

Pool U- Flight Force- 5'10 SG **M.Munger, Franklin Central**, athletic length with wingspan. Shot the ball well showing range from deep behind the arch. Used length on defense to be disruptive.

Pool V- Sky Diggs Huffman – 5-0 Pool winners & final 4 bracket. Down a couple players for the event the 2017 backcourt duo of A.Huffman and P.Saylor carried the load. PG **A.Huffman, Columbus North**, is one of the top true point guards in the class. Fundamental as they come, good handles, court vision, and has become a solid consistent shooter. CG **P.Saylor, Roncalli**, is high motor kid that gets after it on both ends of the court. Always been a solid defender but has really improved her shooting and game on the offensive end.

Pool W- Flight Attack – 5-0 Pool winners. 2017 G **S.Hammell, Pendleton Heights**, strong guard frame, played very physical with high motor. Showed ability to both attack and finish through contact at the rim and hit the jumper. Was really impressed with her intensity of play.
