

2017 IGBRR Indiana Futures Camp



Nearly 100 of Indiana's top young prospects participated in the 2017 Indiana Futures Camp on Saturday September 9th at Triton Central High School. The camp consisted of prospects in the 2021, 2022 and 2023 classes and the participation list can be found at IGBRR.COM. The campers were led in instruction throughout the event by several top trainers and coaches, as well as Acceleration Indiana in sports performance training. The camp consisted of drill to skill stations, sports enhancement training, and both 3 on 3 and 5 on 5 competition. The camp also featured 24 prospects in the Futures 3 point contest, 8 in the Futures 1 on 1 competition and another 26 in the Skills Challenge.



Many of the Futures campers were deserving and got votes for the All-Camp Team. The following earned their way onto the team with their solid and consistent play throughout the day, that was recognized by the training staff during drills, 3v3, 5v5 and skills competitions.

Indiana Futures 3 Point Champion- 2023 Nevaeh Foster, South Bend

Twenty-four of the camp's top shooters participated in the Indiana Futures 3 point contest. There was stiff competition throughout the three rounds, including an eight player sudden death shootout in the first round. 2023 Nevaeh Foster and Lilly Toppen matched each other ball for ball throughout the contest. The championship was no different. Toppen elected to go first and put the pressure on by knocking down six. Nevaeh was up to the task by knocking down her last ball to force sudden death. Indiana Futures 1v1 Champion- 2021 McKenzie Hudgen, John Glenn

Eight very skilled and versatile prospects took on the three round challenge of attempting to be crowned the Indiana Futures 1v1 champion. 2021s McKenzie Hudgen of John Glenn and Gigi Eldredge of Westfield came out of their respective brackets to meet in the final. The final was a fun and physical contest. Hudgen got out front early and captured the 1v1 championship as time expired.

Indiana Futures Camp Skills Challenge Champion- Teresa Maggio, McCutcheon

Twenty-six IGBRR Futures campers took on the skills challenge but 2022 Teresa Maggio left no doubt who would own the course. Maggio produced 3 of the top 4 times on the course on her way to the Skill Challenge Championship. She set a blistering pace out of the gate posting a 17.8 second run, over 1.5 seconds faster than anyone else in the field. She saved her best for last posting the fastest time of the event in winning the Futures Skills Challenge championship with a 17.5 second pass.
