Following are just a few prospects that caught our eye during the last day of the 2017 Club season.....

2018Kenedi London5'7GFishersLady TruthUses extreme athletic ability and strong handle to get into the paint with ease where she is able to get off a variety of shots and<br/>find tough angles. Isn't one you want to leave open from three but needs to improve consistency. Is able to cause opponents<br/>issues when on defense because of her ability to defend at a high level and smother ball handlers.

2018Taelynn Oelling6'0FValparaisoNWI ThunderCombination of size, versatility, skill. Operates well with around the basket with footwork and multiple finishing moves. Can<br/>stretch it with ability to knock down the jumper or put the ball on the floor. Works well off the baseline. Uses size and good<br/>anticipation to get into position to rebound and make plays defensively.

2018Kyra Whitaker5'8GGreensburgIndiana Elite SWISHHas the ability to light it up from the perimeter with a quick, effortless release and range beyond the three point line. Quick<br/>hands defensively, bothers defender into mistakes and turnovers. Gets into the paint off the dribble and is able to create shots<br/>for herself and her teammates.

2019Addy Blackwell5'2PGBloomington SouthIndiana Elite SWISHPlayed with energy and poise all day long. Quick release allows her to get shots off from the perimeter in tight space which she<br/>converts at a high rate. Can break defender down off the dribble and get into the paint where she shows ability to stop on a<br/>dime and hit over the help D.

2019Mallory Johnson5'7GNoblesvilleSky Diggs EliteDangerous from the three point line and can hit off both the catch and the dribble. Plays tough perimeter defense. Is able to get<br/>to the basket off the dribble, especially when attacking poor closeouts. Is able to finish at the rim or find the open shooter.

# 2019 Elexah Roepke 6'0 F South Ripley Flight

Big strong post frame with ability to finish with strength around the basket. Has continued to improve over the course of the club season in using her frame and strength to create space and finish against contact. Aggressively and physically attacks from the mid post and blocks. Rebounds the ball well in her area and runs well block to block.

Quick north/south point that doesn't waste dribbles, plays downhill attacking the paint and putting pressure on the defense. Doesn't have the biggest frame but plays fearless baseline to baseline, with ability to finish against contact. Good court vision with ability to create space for herself and teammates. Active feet and hands on defense, applying pressure on the ball.

# 2020 Caliy Bolser 6'4 F North Miami Indiana's Best

At 6'4 it's hard not to notice Caliy, but her ability to stretch the D with that size is what really grabs your attention. She shows a consistent mid-range jumper with the ability to hit the 3. She has continued to add bulk and strength to her frame as she has matured making her an even tougher matchup as her game in the paint grows. Her length with massive wingspan makes her disruptive and versatile on the defensive end.

2020 Haley Nichols 5'10 F Lafavette Blue Chips Avon Strong forward frame with good instincts and solid skill set. Haley can be a tough match up with the ability to shoot the jumper, use her strength and frame in the paint, with IQ and an overall crafty offensive game. Rebounds the ball well and has good anticipation on the defensive end. 2020 **Taylor Westgate** 6'1 F Oak Hill **Midwest Finest** Played a pivotal role as a frosh on 2A Sate Runner up Oak Hill. Strong forward frame with physical mindset on both ends. Shows good hands and footwork in the post with ability to finish with both athleticism and strength. Aggressive to the boards with foot speed to defend out on the perimeter. 5'7 2021 Jessica Castor G Westfield **Indiana Elite** Hardnosed guard who always finds a way to make plays. Shows the ability to knock down spot-up threes and does a great job of working off the ball to put herself in spots to stretch the defense. Plays tough, physical defense often forcing turnovers and reacts well to the ball, tracking down rebounds and loose balls. 2021 **Alex Richards** 6'0 Faith F Avon Our first look at Alex, she demonstrated a nice combination of strength and athleticism. Broad shoulders, runs the floor well and fluid with the ball around the basket. Very intriguing prospect that appears to have high ceiling tools and could be a break out as she continues to develops wing skill set.

2021Brynn Shoup – Hill6'2FGoshenAlways 100Long, fluid, athletic with solid skill set. Most dominate around the basket using physical attributes to finish and rebound<br/>athletically. Shows versatility with ability to hit jump shot and handle ball on wing or in open court with confidence. As she<br/>continues to develop strength and perimeter skills she will be even more of a matchup issue for opponents.

2022Jozee Rhodes5'10FPlainfieldRed StormWorks extremely hard around the basket with nice combination of strength, athleticism and motor. Shows versatility on both<br/>ends of the floor. Has foot speed, length and strength to defend multiple spots. Goes to the boards with purpose and has the<br/>ability to track down balls out of her area.
