





Marquette Catholic was last year's preseason 1A #1 and went wire to wire in that spot going 27-2 and winning the State Championship. The State tournament is always difficult to navigate but expect to see a Blazers rematch against Vincennes Rivet that saw the title game decided in the final two minutes of the contest. The Blazers return four starters and 93% of their points, including First Team All-State selections Emma and Sophia Nolan. The Patriots return four starters and 93% of their scoring from their state runner-up team as well, including All-State selections Grace Waggoner and Tia Tolbert. Northfield & University bring back talent and experience from 18 win teams and will be contenders as well.

Two other seniors who provide major contributions include guards Emery Joseph 5.7 APG and Morgan Crook 6.3 PPG & 3.4 APG. Senior C.Sayler and junior A.McConnell will provide depth. The 2019 class has led the Blazers to 72 wins over the last three seasons and are poised to continue with another run back to the state championship.






