

4A Indiana High School Preview

Add three of last season's top 3A squads, which are moving up to the 4A level, to several of last year's top 4A squads that are returning large portions of their production and you have a deep and talented 4A field. Pike, last year's State Runner-up, returns the core of that team led by Miss Basketball candidate Angel Baker. The Red Devils will be without Roberson, who will be out a majority of the regular season with an injury, but have added talented transfer guard Keith. Several other MIC conference teams join Pike in the top twenty including Carmel who returns four starters including Miss Basketball candidate Amy Dilk. The Greyhounds also possess one of the deepest benches in the state. North Central who finished the regular season undefeated and ranked number one last season, suffered an early blow with the loss of senior and Indiana All-Star candidate Taylor Ramey to injury but still have a talented lineup. Jeffersonville. Bedford North Lawrence and North Harrison may be tops out of the south. However, only one will emerge from perhaps the state's top Sectionals (15). Several other talented squads have the tools and experience to make an impact as well, including HSE, Martinsville (Miss Basketball candidate Kayana Traylor) and East Chicago Central (Miss Basketball candidate Jenasae Bishop) to name a few.

Carmel a top 5 squad throughout the 2016-17 campaign returns four starters and 89% of its offensive production. Leading the way for the Greyhounds will be 2018 Indiana Miss Basketball candidate and *University of Michigan* commit Amy Dilk 14.8 PPG, 6.6 RPG, 6.4 APG. The balance attack, which scored 63.3 a contest, also includes senior sharp shooter (*Iowa commit*) Tomi Taiwo 14 PPG, 6'3 (*Ball State commit*) Blake Smith 8.4 PPG & 5.8 RPG and 2020 Jazmine McWilliams 6 PPG & 6.8 RPG. Carmel also shows plenty of depth which includes 2019's M. Wood, R. Hune and M. Berglund, along with senior M. Gillig and sophomore M. Sears. Carmel who lost in the Elite 8 to eventual state champ Homestead, appear to be aligned for another deep run in the post season.

The Red Devil post season run almost didn't get started, but after an opening sectional game OT win they went on a nail biting run to the State championship game where they fell to Homestead 54-61. Pike returns four starters and 86% of their offensive production from the state runner-up squad. Led by a pair of Indiana All-Star candidates in (*Wright State commit*) Angel Baker 19.4 PPG, 5.7 RPG, 4 APG and (*Indiana State commit*) Michaela White 11.3 PPG & 9 RPG. Pike will be without junior J. Roberson 10 PPG for most of the season due to injury but have added Attucks transfer M. Keith 15.2 PPG. Both junior K. Garrard 8.9 PPG & 7.3 RPG and senior M. Brown will give productive minutes as well. The inside/outside balance should once again make Pike a legit force for another run in the tournament.

Hamilton Southeastern has had a lot of young talent on the floor over the last two seasons, that talent now has the experience to be as capable as any team in the state. HSE is led by the state's top 2020 prospect in 6'1 Sydney Parrish 16.2 PPG and 5.7 RPG. The Royals return a good part of their core but will need to replace Bre Lloyd's, *Wright State*, production 14.4 PPG. A trio of high level juniors are very capable T. Irvin 5.4 PPG, A. Hamilton 6.6 PPG & 5.5 RPG and M. Jackson 8.9 PPG. M. Walton 4.3 PPG and L. Morris and will add depth to the backcourt. HSE will need to solve cross county rival Carmel come sectional time.

2019 5'10 Guard Rikki Harris

They always say it's difficult to beat a quality opponent three times in a season. The Panthers entered the post season as the undefeated 4A #1. However, North Central lost in the Regional final in their third matchup of the season against eventual state runner-up, and MIC foe, Pike 59-61. North Central will return several key components from that talented squad, graduating Indiana State recruit Ajanae Thomas and losing senior sharpshooter Taylor Ramey 11 PPG (IUPUI commit) to injury. The Panther lineup will feature junior all-star candidate Rikki Harris 17.4 PPG. Senior Ajah Stallings 10.6 PPG (Purdue commit) and junior Savaya Brockington 5.9 PPG are also key forces on both ends of the floor. The high powered offense averaged over 66 points a contest, which was eighth in the state. The combination of an experienced skilled core and a tough schedule should have the Panthers prepared for a tournament run.

The Red Devils have averaged 16 wins over the last four seasons, very respectful, but this should be the year they break through and approach that 20 win mark. They return 8 players that saw significant court time last season and are led by senior (Western Michigan commit) Jacinta Gibson 8 PPG. 2020 Nan Garcia 7.3 PPG 4.4 RPG mad a big splash as a frosh last season. Seniors J. Brown and B. Epperson, along with juniors T. Handley, C. Gibson, J. Lilly, are all capable of making significant contributions. The Red Devils have the size, skill, depth and experience to be a serious contender coming out of the south.

Led by Indiana Miss Basketball candidate and *Purdue* commit Kayana Traylor 23.4 PPG, 5.3 RPG, 4.5 APG. Also part of the 2018 class are Jessica Nix 8.2 PPG &7.1 RPG, Merideth Deckard 12.4 PPG, and *(Chicago State commit)* Christina Alexander. Look for significant contributions from 2019s B. Mackin, G. Johnson and P. Dorsett as well. Sophomore 6'2 M. Kemp could produce promising minutes too. Martinsville has the elements that should allow for a promising season, including outside/inside balance, experience, depth, and a Miss Basketball candidate to lean on.

2019 6'1 Forward Lilly Hatton

North Harrison has made a two year run that has produced a 55-6 record and two State Runner-up finishes in 3A. The Lady Cats will move up to 4A due to the IHSAA success factor. However, returning 90% of the offensive production and experience should translate to a successful 4A campaign for the Cats. 2019 Junior All-Star candidate Lilly Hatton 20.1 PPG 8.9 RPG leads the way with senior and Indiana All-Star candidate (*Kentucky Wesleyan commit*) Cali Nolot 13.5 PPG 3.8 APG making up the second head of the monster. Seniors T. Rennirt 8.3 PPG 3.6 APG, H. Hinton, and E. Nokes will all contribute. Sophomore 6'2 L. Robertson should start to emerge as well. The biggest questions at the 4A level will be depth and schedule but the experience and talent is there to compete.

The last three seasons have resulted in a State Championship, Final Four and a State runner-up. The Spartans were two overtime loses away from a perfect State championship season. The senior core of those teams are now gone including Miss Basketball and *Purdue* commit Karissa McLaughlin 25.9 PPG along with Madisen Parker (*Bowling Green*) 16.8 PPG and Jazmyne Geist (*Northern Kentucky*) 10 PPG 8 RPG. However, plenty of talent remains that's capable of keeping the train on the tracks. Junior Haley Swing 4PPG & 4.5 RPG started on the State Championship team, while 2020 Sydney Graber got significant minutes as a frosh 3.5 PPG & 4.7 RPG. K. Gealy, S. Buck and B. Lucus look to be key pieces as well. Junior All-Star candidate Sylare Starks 15.9 PPG, formerly FW Concordia, may be the most significant transfer of the off season and will provide a big offensive punch for the Spartans. Homestead may be a year away from another deep run but they will hold their own in the 2017-18 campaign.

The Stars have been a 4A powerhouse for the last 7 years, which includes their 2014 State Championship. That should continue this year behind junior all-star candidate Jorie Allen 17.7 PPG 10.3 RPG. BNL returns three quarters of their offensive production from a team that posted 21 wins and an Elite 8 appearance. They will need to replace the production of graduated Kennedy Bunch 11.8 PPG but have several experienced players to lean on in senior M. Messmore 7.3 PPG, and juniors A. Fugate 6.9 PPG and J. Hughes 5.5 PPG. 2020 6'2 M. Webb will also play a key role as she returns from an injury that keep her out last season.

They return nearly 78% of their offensive production including Indiana All-Star candidate (*Miami commit*), Nia Clark 18.6 PPG. 2020 Khera Goss brings versatility and put together a solid freshman campaign 8.6 PPG 4.1 RPG but will be sidelined until December. Fellow sophomore Cherrelle Newsome knocked down 38 threes in her opening season. Ben Davis has a backcourt that can handle itself against any opponent, the question will be the production up front on both ends. The Giants who have won 24 sectionals haven't added to that total in the last five seasons.

The reins will be handed over to junior all-star candidate Trinity Brady 15 PPG & 7.8, who has a stack of D1 offers herself. An outstanding sophomore class will be a major part of the contribution as well in Katie Davidson 9.1 PPG & 5.2 RPG, Lauren Gunn and Kristen Young. Freshman Jayla Smith could make an immediate impact as well.

With seven State championships since 2006 the Eagles have worked their way up from 2A to 4A. The Eagles posted its fifth consecutive 20 win season before falling in the 3A Final Four to eventual State champ South Bend St Joseph. Heritage Christian lost over 40% of its scoring to graduation but returns one of the state's best backcourts. Led by Indiana Miss Basketball candidate and *Notre Dame commit* Katlyn Gilbert 16.8 PPG 7.5 RPG. The backcourt also includes 2018 H. Harris 6.8 PPG, 2019 M. Ferguson 3.1 PPG, 2020 Watkins 4.4 PPG. 2021 A. Wiggins, who has already received multiple D1 offers, is considered one of top incoming Indiana frosh and is anticipated to make a big contribution immediately. Around the basket junior Shelby Case will shoulder the load. The Eagles traditionally play one of the state's top schedules and will have already been tested against the state's best come 4A sectional time.

Never count out a team full of shooters but the ability to defend around the basket and rebound will determine their success.

They return 75% of their production from last year, led by senior guard (*Huntington commit*) Sara Doi 12.4 PPG & 3.8 APG. Fellow senior Tia Chambers, who is returning from a knee injury, 11.2 PPG 6.5 RPG will provide the interior presence. Sophomore Reganne Pate 7.6 is coming off a solid freshman season and junior Makenzie Kilmer 4.2 PPG will provide production as well.
