

2020 IGBRR Indiana Futures Camp



Ninety of Indiana's top young prospects participated in the 2020 Indiana Futures Camp on Sunday August 30th at Boys & Girls Club of Noblesville. The camp consisted of prospects in the 2024, 2025 and 2026 classes and the participation list can be found at IGBRR.COM. The campers were led in instruction throughout the event by several of state's top trainers, coaches and upperclassmen. The camp consisted of drill to skill stations, sports enhancement training, and both 3 on 3 and 5 on 5 competition. The camp also featured 16 prospects in the Futures 3-point contest, 28 in the Futures Hot Shot competition and another 16 in the Skills Challenge.

Indiana Futures 3 Point Champion 2024 Kennedy Fuelling Norwell

Sixteen of the camp's top shooters participated in the Indiana Futures 3-point contest. There was stiff competition throughout the three rounds, including a three-way tie to get out of the first round that was won in a shootout by the eventual champion. Three bombers connected on 6 threes in that round, including runner-up 25' Kayla Tamm. 24' Kennedy Fuelling would win the semi-final round with 7 triples, while Kayla Tamm hit another 6 to advance to the finals with Fuelling. Indiana Futures Hot Shot Champion 2024 Alli Harness Carroll

Twenty-eight of the Futures campers participated in the Hot Shot competition. The participants were given 45 seconds to accumulate points by knocking down shots from various spots worth different point values. 24' Riley Pepple set the pace in the first round pacing the eight who advanced with 32 points. 25' Maya Makalusky would win the semi-final round and advance to the finals with a 32-point round, while 24' Alli Harness would net 25 points to secure the other spot. Harness would put on an incredible show in the finals connecting on 8 of 9 triples and collecting 42 points to capture the 2020 Futures Hot Shot Championship. Indiana Futures Skills Challenge Champion 2024 Morgan Roberts Fishers

Sixteen IGBRR Futures campers took on the Skills Challenge course. Eight advanced to the semi-finals led by defending champion 24' Morgan Roberts with a 15.75 first round best.
