Scott has also officiated four (4) Boys Basketball State Championship games and is also a licensed IHSAA baseball official calling four (4) State Championships on the diamond.

Scott is a member of the Southwestern Officials Association and has served as served as Baseball Chair and Basketball Chair over time. He has volunteered as an IHSAA Basketball Certification Clinician on numerous occasions, assisting with clinics and trainings in service to other officials in his community. Scott also takes time to mentor new officials and umpires in his community and officiates and coaches in local youth basketball leagues annually.

The most enjoyable aspect of officiating to Scott is the relationships that it has brought to his life, whether it be fellow officials, coaches, or administrators.


