

### 2024 IGBRR All-Indiana Showcase

One hundred of Indiana's top girls high school basketball prospects participated in the 10<sup>th</sup> annual IGBRR All-Indiana Showcase on Sunday August 11th at Triton Central High School. The showcase included players from all four high school classes 2025-28' and the registration list can be found online. The underclass included top prospects within their respective classes. The 2025 senior class included uncommitted prospects that played in front of NAIA/D3 college coaches that were recruiting them.

The event started with ninety minutes of station work. The participants rotated between four skill stations. The next three hours of the event included three rounds of forty-eight-minute running clock games. The showcase teams were coached by some of the top trainers in Indiana. The event concluded with the naming of the All-Indiana Showcase Team as voted by the event's coaches and evaluators. # 2025 AIS Class

### Kyleigh Lehiy 2025 / 5'9 / CG / North Judson

While we were familiar with Kyleigh, mainly from hudl video, this was our first live look and she represented herself very well in the talented field. She has some length, a strong athletic frame and moves well in all directions. She is comfortable with the ball and pushing it in transition and can make fluid plays attacking the bucket with nice agility. She will go get rebounds against forwards, defends several spots and has a nice versatility to her overall game. A prospect that doesn't play club ball that coaches need to be aware of and she opened some eyes at the showcase.

### Samara Miller 2025 / 5'7 / PG / Floyd Central

We first took note of Samara over the winter at a high school holiday tournament and came away impressed with her backcourt game and was able to track her some over the club season as well. She is a crafty point guard, with an athletic game, and great instincts for the action. She does a nice job of facilitating and setting up teammates and makes good decisions with the ball while on the attack. She a capable shooter out to the three-point line, finds the seam in the D and stays aggressive with an overall balanced backcourt game.

### Samantha Roadruck 2025 / 5'7 / CG / Whiteland

First noted Sam over the high school season this year and was able to view her a few more times this spring/summer and a tough nosed competitor is what you consistently get. She is a solid athlete, with a strong guard frame and a nice motor. She is going to make plays on both ends with her tenacity and instincts and is a solid defender. She was a vocal leader on and off the floor throughout the day, cheering on teammates, which is a nice attribute for the senior backcourt prospect.

### Caroline Sampson 2025 / 6'1 / PF / Zionsville

Caroline has been a solid contributor on some very talented Zionsville squads over the last couple years and has continued to progress her game. She has a long strong forward frame, shows as a nice athlete, and is active on both ends of the floor. She can defend most forwards and wings with her agility and strength, aggressively goes to the boards and rebounds her area well and is a capable scorer out of the mid-post. She is positioned to have a breakout senior season as she will need to shoulder an increased load for the Eagles this season.

### Madison Sonsini 2025 / 6'0 / SF / Greenfield-Central

Madison has shown to be a bit of a chameleon, by necessity, over the last several years. We have seen her start off as a shooter from the wing early in her career, to playing some from the backout in previous club seasons, to playing more around the basket this last high school campaign. Ultimately, that has developed and provided a lot of versatility to her game. She has a long strong 6'0 frame, a nice lefty stroke out to the three-point line and is comfortable handling the ball as needed. Probably more of wing at the next level but has shown she is willing and capable of playing about any spot on the floor.

### Rylea Wetz 2025 / 5'11 / PF / McCutchen

I recall noting Rylea's potential her frosh season playing varsity at Tipton and she has continued to progress as she has made a couple other stops and is now at McCutchen as a senior. She is a multi-sport athlete, with a strong forward frame and a good deal of agility. She has a solid game out of the mid-post where she can put together strong physical attacks or knock down the 12-15' jumper. She goes hard to the boards on both ends and can defend a few different spots with her strength and mobility. We, and other coaches, noted her energy and vocal leadership throughout the event. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

# 2026 AIS Class

### Addy Barnes 2026 / 5'4 / PG / Delta

We have seen Addy several times over the last few years in multiple settings and thought Sunday was one of her best showings. As usual she was confident and aggressive on the attack, was able to create space for herself and teammates and showed the ability to create scoring opportunities in a variety of ways. She finished consistently at the showcase and was efficient. She can handle as primary, is poised and is a playmaker on both ends. She has moved to Delta and would expect she will be a big part of what will be a high impact junior class this coming season. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Makaylee Butts 2026 / 5'3 / PG / Avon

We have seen a lot of Makaylee over the last couple years and she had a nice sophomore season for Avon and would expect her to continue to elevate her production. She was on the attack throughout the day showcasing her athleticism and motor and as a playmaker in the backcourt. She can handle as a primary as needed, has a nice feel for the action and shows the ability to get buckets in a variety of ways. She is active on the defensive end with quick hands and feet. Solid balance and production from the backcourt

# Brinley Clark 2026 / 5'10 / SG / Floyd Central

We were familiar with Brinley coming into the club season, even saw a couple high school games over the winter, but thought she had an outstanding spring/summer and took a fairly significant jump in our summer watchlist. She continued that play at AIS with a really nice performance showing she can be productive among the elite ranks. She has some nice length, moves well, displays a nice balance in her game with the ability to score the ball from all levels. She has nice versatility with her size, agility and perimeter skills. A prospect to keep an eye on over the next couple years that is on the rise in the class.

### Kelis Dansby 2026 / 5'8 / CG / Jeffersonville

Kelis is one the top playmaking guards in the class. The combination of her athleticism and point guard skillset make her electric in the open court. She can handle as a primary, shows high level court vision and awareness while on the attack and can get buckets in a variety of ways. She shows overall good instincts for the play, and has high end athleticism in her game. She will be moving to 4A Jeffersonville this year which only help with her continued development.

# Chloe Finney 2026 / 5'9 / SF / McCutcheon

Chloe opened our eyes at last year's AIS and she has been a stock riser ever since. She had a solid sophomore campaign at 4A McCutchen and was extremely productive on the club circuit this season during our views. She has a strong guard frame, has a physicality to her game and a sneaky athleticism. She can score the ball at all levels, is comfortable handling it and has the strength and moxie to mix it up at the bucket both on the boards and defensively. McCutcheon will be one of the stronger 4A teams this season and she will be a big part of that equation. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Grace Goldman 2026 / 5'10 / SF / North Harrison

Grace is a very intriguing prospect in the class. She has all the tools from a strong physical frame, to an aggressiveness in her game, to a solid mix of guard and forward skills. She continues to progress and is consistently showing she belongs among the elite prospects in the class. She had as good a day as anyone at the showcase and was consistently active and productive. The combination of length, strength, and skill make her one of the more versatile prospects in the class. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Izabell Grantz 2026 / 5'7 / PG / Castle

Talent just seems to pour out of the Castle program and Izabell is a part of those skilled, athletic and savvy players. She had an outstanding prospect camp last year and she was equally as good at AIS this year. Strong guard frame, big motor, physicality and aggressiveness from the guard spot. Shows good instincts and is one of those kids that is going to make the play. Solid decision maker, poised, and has continued to elevate her scoring prowess where she can buckets at a fairly high level. Probably still a bit under the radar for what she consistently brings in our views and one that coaches should track over the next two years. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Alexis Neely 2026 / 5'7 / CG / Warsaw

Alexis is part of an extremely talented junior class at Warsaw and a few of those holding D1 offers so it may be easy to get lost a bit in the mix but have no doubt that Alexis can compete against anyone in class as she proved Sunday. She can handle from the point, has a strong guard frame, finds the open teammate while on the attack, and can go get buckets of her own. Solid athlete from the backcourt, tough nose athletic defender and will track down boards from the guard spot. Nice balance in her game. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Brynn Owens 2026 / 5'7 / CG / Austin

Brynn has shined at our last two AIS events, consistently showing that she is among the elite prospects in the class. She is a solid athlete, with nice instincts for the action and a ton of skill to mix in. She can handle from the point, and can score the ball at all levels including knocking down the long ball in bunches. Deceptively athletic going to rim where she can score it with her agility or read and find the open teammate. One of the top bucket getters in the class that can score it consistently at a high level.

### Aly Powers 2026 / 5'9 / SF / Greensburg

Aly had a really nice showing at AIS, including leading all prospects at 22.5 PPG during game play. She has some length, is a nice athlete and shows solid instincts for the action. She can score the ball at all levels in a variety of ways with the ability create space and shots on her own. She is part of an extremely talented Greensburg crew that should be in position to make a run to state. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Anna Sachire 2026 / 6'1 / PF / Penn

Have had the opportunity to see Anna a lot over the years and always liked the upside with her length and the ability to be comfortable with the ball on the block or wing. However, thought she took it to a different level at AIS showing the ability and aggressiveness to score the ball at a high level in a variety of ways. As noted, she has a long strong forward frame. can operate around the bucket with nice hands and feet and can extend to the three-point line. She will rebound her area and can defend a few different spots with her length and mobility. She was among the top scorers in game play averaging 22 PPG.

# 2027 AIS Class

### Alanna Anthony 2027 / 5'10 / SF / Fishers

Alanna has a strong long frame, along with a solid balanced skillset. She is comfortable with the ball from the wing, can put together athletic attacks and can work out of the mid-post. She has a physicalness to her game and presents a matchup issue with her size and athleticism. I would imagine she will see an increased role for her Tigers after getting varsity minutes last season as a frosh.

## Audrey Burton 2027 / 6'0 / SF / Bloomington North

Audrey had a solid frosh season and is blossoming into one of the more versatile wings in the class. She is long, has wingspan, and shows a good deal of agility. She is comfortable on the attack with the ball, sees the floor well and has a nice balance of setting up teammates and getting buckets. A capable shooter out to the three-point line, solid mid-range game and can operate at the bucket with her length. As she continues to add strength she will become a match-up issue as she shoulders more of a load for the Cougars this season.

### Alivia Dawson 2027 / 5'8 / CG / Penn

Alivia is an athletic crafty guard that is aggressive and confident on the attack. She is able to create her own shots at all levels and can get buckets in bunches. She can handle from the point as needed, has a quick step slashing to the bucket and finishes with a good deal of athleticism. Reminds me a bit of a Katie Burton as an athletic playmaker and has a good deal of upside as she continues to develop as a consistent finisher. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Cayleigh Goheen 2027 / 5'11 / PF / Warsaw

Was not overly familiar with Cayleigh coming in but thought she had a very nice day with multiple coaches commenting on her performance. She has a strong frontcourt frame, moves well and has some physicality to her game at the bucket. She showed the ability to attack out of the mid-post, finished with touch and made plays with a nice motor. Rebounds her area and stays active on both ends. Look forward to seeing her development over the next couple of years.

### Arianna Harrington 2027 / 5'7 / CG / North Central

Arianna had a nice frosh season at the 4A level in the MIC which says a lot about her promise. She is an athletic guard that stays on the attack and has playmaking ability on both ends of the court. She can handle the ball as needed, has a quick step and can get the edge where she can setup teammates or finish going to the bucket. Plays with a nice motor, a solid on ball defender, and can go track down rebounds from the guard spot. Big upside with her athleticism and growing backcourt skillset.

### Chesney Jackson 2027 / 6'0 / PF / Charlestown

Had the opportunity to see Chesney a few times over the high school season, where she had a big frosh campaign, and again many times over the club season. She is long, agile and has a good deal of versatility to her game. She rebounds the ball at a high clip with her length and agility, can defend several spots with her size and mobility and has a developing offensive skillset. While she is comfortable with the ball from the wing most of her damage comes from around the basket right now. As she continues to develop her attack from the wing she has a goo deal of upside.

### Izzy Like 2027 / 5'5 / PG / Evansville Mater Dei

Saw Izzy a few times last summer, with SIM, and noted her promise as she entered her frosh season where she had a productive year for her Wildcats. Didn't get to see her as much this club season but was looking forward to seeing her compete against some of the top prospects at AIS, and she didn't disappoint. Athletic aggressive play from the guard spot where she shows the ability to breakdown the defense and create space for herself and teammates while on the attack. Despite being on the smaller side she is able to get off shots at the second level with her agility and athleticism. She plays with a nice motor and is a playmaker on both ends. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Kara Olejnik 2027 / 5'9 / SF / Plainfield

Kara has a good deal of versatility in her game. She has a strong frame, an aggressive demeanor and physicality to her play. She can make plays around the bucket with her strength and agility and shows she can extend to the wing and make plays going to the bucket. At 5'9 her continued development from the perimeter would suit her well. She rebounds her area and can defend a few different spots with her size and mobility. She stays active with a nice motor and puts pressure on her matchup with that aggressive physical play.

### Sadey Ringler 2027 / 5'9 / SG / Harrison

This time next year we could be talking about Sadey being a breakout player in the class. She has a lot of the tools that will make her productive when she gets into the regular rotation at the varsity level. She has a strong guard frame, sneaky athleticism and shows the ability to create her own shots and scores it at all levels. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, can get to the rim where she finishes with agility and shows good instincts for the game on both ends. She had an outstanding day at AIS showing her ability to score it against elite competition.

### Hallie Schwieterman 2027 / 5'8 / CG / Jay County

Each year we seem to have a prospect that creates a lot of buzz with their high level of play from start to finish and this year that prospect was Hallie. Her athleticism and instincts make her a consistent playmaker on both ends. She has a strong guard frame, shows as a nice athlete and plays with a solid motor. She displays the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways, has the quickness and agility to create going to the bucket and is a finisher. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Brooke Silva 2027 / 5'9 / SG / Evansville North

We have noted Brooke's play on multiple occasions over the club season and she continued her high level play at AIS against the elite competition. She is long, has a strong guard frame and shows a lot versatility to her game. She is comfortable handling the ball when needed, can score it all levels and shoots it well out to the three-point line. Her combination of length, strength and skillset give her a good deal of upside. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

### Marley Warren 2027 / 5'5 / PG / Trinity Lutheran

Marley is one of the top true point guards in the class. Her game is mature beyond her years, plays with a great instincts, has a nice balance to her game and seems to be extremely productive in each setting we view her in. She handles with poise, has great court vision and shoots it well from deep. She reminds us a bit of former Indiana All-Star Holly Hoopingarner, on the smaller side but gets it done from a high bball IQ and skill standpoint. A standout at AIS and was selected by the coaches to the All-Showcase team.

# 2028 AIS Class

### Kendra Ash 2028 / 6'1 / PF / Fishers

We have been familiar with Kendra for a few years from camps and playing on high level club teams and it's no surprise that she had a nice showing against her older high school peers. She has a long strong forward frame, shows a good deal of agility and has good hands and feet around the basket. She is comfortable with the ball away from the bucket as well, can attack out of the mid-post and has really nice upside with her combination of size, agility and skill as an incoming frosh.

### Luci Reich 2028 / 5'8 / CG / Huntington North

Luci popped on our radar this club season with her athletic skilled play from the backcourt. She can handle the ball as a primary when needed, stays active and on the attack on both ends and plays with a nice motor. She displays the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways, and has the ability to knock down the long ball. Active defender with nice instincts that can go get boards from the guard spot. Suspect it won't take her long to be making a big impact at the varsity level for her Vikings

### Ava Richie 2028 / 5'6 / CG / Crown Point

Ava is an athletic playmaking guard that has an aggressive productive game on both ends. She can handle as a primary, can make plays on the attack with her athleticism and instincts and shows a balanced overall backcourt game. Solid on ball defender with quick hands and feet and doesn't mind mixing up it. Suspect that she will see the varsity floor fairly quickly in her career with her athleticism and ability to make plays from the guard spot.

### Zoie Walls 2028 / 5'10 / CG / Monrovia

Zoie has a ton of upside as she starts her high school career with her combination of length, skill and motor. She has a guard skillset, a long athletic frame and a good deal of agility. She can get buckets in a variety of ways and has a tremendous amount of versatility to her game. As she continues to add strength, she is an extremely difficult matchup with her combination of physical and ball skills. Expect her to make an immediate impact at the varsity level for her Bulldogs.

### Caroline Wiggins 2028 / 6'0 / SF / Cathedral

Caroline has about as much upside as anyone we have seen in the class with her combination of size and skill. She has a strong forward frame while showing the ability and skillset to operate from the perimeter. She is aggressive and physical on the attack, and can score the ball in a variety of ways with her length and agility. She can defend and play most spots on the floor with a good deal of versatility and shows nice instincts on both ends. She fit in nicely with her older talented peers at the showcase.

### Zoey Wood 2028 / 5'5 / PG / Mt Vernon

Zoey is another incoming frosh we are very familiar with from her outstanding play from our past Futures camps. She is a highly skilled guard that has a feel for the game well beyond her years. She can handle as primary, sets-up teammates repeatedly while on the attack and can get buckets in bunches in a variety of ways. High motor, highly skilled and is a tough nosed competitor. Would expect that she will be in the rotation for her 4A Marauders fairly soon and has the skillset to put up some big high school numbers.
