Hailey Conder 2027 / 5'4 / CG / South Central / Lady Gym Rats

Hailey was a late add to the showcase and boy did she ever take advantage with a productive day which included the highest single game with a 30-point effort. She is a bit on the smaller side, but she really knows how to create space and use change of pace to create shots. She can light it up from deep and is agile on the attack and is a crafty finisher. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, plays with a good motor and can put the ball in the bucket. She was voted by the coaches and evaluators to the All-Showcase team.



Audrina Dugan 2027 / 5'9 / SG / East Central / Indiana Pride

We have seen Audrina several times over the club season and really like the motor and toughness she plays with on both ends. She has a strong frame, is on the attack and puts a lot of pressure on her matchup. Mixes it up on the offensive end as a capable shooter and physical downhill attacks. A solid athlete that will grab boards against forwards and a versatile defender. She is a big part of what should be a strong Trojan attack this coming season.



Grace Fischer 2027 / 5'10 / SG / Waldron / IBC

Grace made her return from a knee injury this spring and has continued to progress as one of the more intriguing prospects in the class. She is long, agile, and shows a lot of upside and versatility on both ends. She can get buckets at all levels, is a solid athlete on the attack, can go grab boards with her length and can defend multiple spots. I would expect that she will have a monster season for the Mohawks this fall and is a bit of an under the radar prospect in the class, after losing a season to injury, that could bust out in the next year.



Lanie French 2027 / 5'7 / CG / Bellmont / Always 100

We just noted Lanie over the July exposure period for her motor and tough nosed play from the backcourt. She does a lot of the little things but is a skilled guard as well that can shoot the rock, is comfortable handling it as needed and is consistently in the mix making plays on both ends. We want to also point out she was the first one willing to jump in and help a short-handed team as well, gamer.



Cayleigh Goheen 2027 / 5'10 / PF / Warsaw / Always 100

Cayleigh is a very intriguing frontline prospect. She may get lost in the mix a bit with the talent on the 4A state runner-up Tigers squad, but she is a physical high motor presence that is productive and efficient with her chances. She will set the strong screen, go hard to the boards, and is a physical presence on both ends. She also shows nice touch at the basket, can put together attacks out of the mid-post and is a capable mid-range jump shooter. Expect to see her role increase this year with the graduation of Winchester.



Jayda Kempf 2027 / 5'7 / CG / Providence / Southern Indiana Flight

Jayda is a bit under the radar backcourt prospect in the 27' class. She is a smooth and skilled guard that can score the ball in a variety of ways. She can knock down the three with range, is agile and skilled on the attack, and can handle the ball as a primary as needed. She is a proven scorer across multiple formats of play (HS ,Club, Showcase), as she displayed at AIS. She was voted by the coaches and evaluators to the All-Showcase team.



Izzy Like 2027 / 5'5 / PG / Evansville Mater Dei / DistinXion

We been high on Izzy's play for awhile and she is another guard prospect in the 27' class that is a bit under the radar that coaches need on their watchlist. She brings dynamic athletic play from the backcourt, with a natural feel for the game. She has nice balance between setting up teammates where she has good court vision on the attack and the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways. Her productive athletic playmaking ability shines on both ends of the court. She had another productive showing at AIS.



Ja'Nyia Rogers 2027 / 5'6 / PG / Purdue Poly / West Virginia Thunder

Wasn't overly familiar with Ja'Nyia coming into the high school season but have seen her several times since in both HS and club ball and she has shown a solid athletic backcourt game. She can handle as a primary, shows her athleticism on the attack and in the open court and has a nice balance between facilitating and getting buckets. Stays active and engaged on both ends as playmaker. She had a solid day at AIS, including a 19 point game.



Izzy Silcox 2027 / 5'7 / SG / Greenfield Central / IBC

Izzy has been a solid guard prospect in the class for a while now. She already has a couple years of 4A varsity experience under her belt and is known for her ability to knock down the long ball in bunches. She can handle the ball as needed, plays with good instincts and as she has continued to add strength the rest of her skillset has progressed. She was productive throughout the event in both drills and games.



Amelia Story 2027 / 5'6 / SG / Purdue Poly / Elevate Hoops

We were able to catch Amelia a couple times during the high school season and then again in July with her club team. She is a coach's kid and that basketball IQ shows through, along with her shooting ability out to the three-point line. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, sees the floor well while on the move, and plays with nice poise and pace. She has a solid showing at AIS, including a 18-point game.



Madalynn Warnock 2027 / 5'6 / PG / Charlestown / Southern Indiana Flight

We have highlighted Maddie a few times over the last couple months, and she continues to have a really nice summer. She has some length, an athletic game on both ends and as she has continued to add strength her skillset has blossomed. She can handle as a primary, is quick and agile on the attack and has nice balance between setting up teammates and getting buckets. Solid on ball defender with her quick feet and hands. She stays active and is constantly in the mix on both ends as an athletic playmaker.



Etta Young 2027 / 5'10 / SF / Jennings County / IGB

Etta is a bit of diamond in the ruff in the 27' class with a lot of upside and versatility. Her role has continued to grow at the high school level and she has been efficient with her chances. She can play around the basket with her strength and length but her game extends to the wing where she is comfortable with the ball, can knock down the jumper and is agile and fluid on the move. She rebounds against forwards and can defend a few different spots. Nice combination of size and versatility, with a little gritty to her game.
