Saydee Arnold 2026/5'10 / PF / Southridge / Havoc

We had seen Saydee a few times over the years and was glad we were able to get a more extended look in the showcase setting. She has a long strong frontcourt frame, is active on both ends where she does a nice job using her mobility and wingspan to be disruptive defensively and rebound the ball. Offensively she flashes some versatility with the strength and agility to get buckets at the basket while stepping out and being an effective jump shooter out to the three-point line. She has nice combination of productive size and versatility.



Shiloh DeBoard 2026 / 5'7 / SG / North Judson

I believe we have only seen Shiloh twice, both of those being at the AIS, but she has made an nice impression in those views. She is a solid athlete, that has a good feel for the game, that is consistently in the mix on both ends. The lefty guard can handle the ball as needed, is a capable shooter and is physical in her downhill attacks and gets to the free throw line. She will go track down boards from the backcourt and plays with nice energy on the defensive end. A bit of an under the radar backcourt senior prospect.



Eliana Stewart 2026 / 5'8 / SF / Kokomo / IBC

Eliana has a strong athletic frame and has continued to progress her game over the last couple of years. She shows a lot of athleticism on her attacks to the basket, is physical and agile on her finishes and plays with nice motor. She can go get boards against bigger forwards and is a versatile defender with her strength, size and mobility. The up and down action suited her game well and she had a nice productive showing throughout the event.



Sarah Thompson 2026/5'9/SF/Oregon Davis

We had seen Sarah on video and her high production in box scores over the last several years but was really excited to get her the gym for our first live views. She has a long strong frame, is active and agile around the basket with a nose for the ball off the rim. Good hands and feet on the frontline, comfortable making the pass from the wing, and has a nice combination of size and mobility that lends to some versatility on both ends.



Sevan Walls 2026 / 5'7 / CG / Crispus Attucks / Indy Magic

We have seen Sevan a lot over the last year across all forums of play and like her upside as an athletic playmaking guard and she bolstered that with a standout day at AIS as the only player to put up multiple 20+ games. She can handle as a primary, is quick and shifty on the move and shows as an athletic playmaker on both ends. She is explosive on her downhill attacks, crafty and agile shot creator on the way to the bucket and excels in transition. She can be disruptive on the defensive end with her quick feet and hands. Sevan was named to the All-Showcase team by coaches and evaluators.
