A look at six of the 2029 freshman prospects from the IGBRR All-Indiana Showcase on August 3<sup>rd</sup> at Triton Central High School.



### **Addison Blum 2029 / 5'8 / SG / Hamilton Heights / West Virginia**

Addison was one of three talented incoming frosh representing the Huskies program at AIS and she had a solid showing throughout the event in drills and game play, which included a 19-point performance. She has a strong guard frame, a good feel for the game and can knock down shots in bunches out to the three-point line. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, understands spacing and angles and stays shot ready around the arch as a confident shooter. Look for her to make an immediate impact at the varsity level this fall.



### **Sophie Buening 2029 / 5'7 / CG / Greensburg / Indiana Pride**

Sophie has solid all-around guard skillset, is a nice athlete and plays with a good motor. She will most likely be a part of the 3A state runner-up Pirates rotation right away and will make an immediate impact this coming season as a frosh. She can handle as a primary, has a balanced backcourt game, and nice instincts for the game. She was consistent and productive throughout the event, including a 23 and 15 point effort in game play. She was voted onto the All-Showcase Team by the coaches and evaluators.



### **Laine Lyles 2029 / 5'10 / CG / Culver Academies / Kentucky Premier**

Laine is one of the hottest prospects in Indiana regardless of class right now. She started as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader at the varsity level in Tennessee last year, now at Culver Academies, she picked up multiple high D1 offers over the July eval period. She is a five-tool player that has an incredible amount of upside to her game. She has a long strong backcourt frame, her game oozes with elite athleticism and she has a developed skillset that allows her to score the ball in a variety of ways. She gets off her feet really well as an athletic finisher and rebounder and can defend several spots with her physical tools. She was a standout throughout the showcase as a frosh.



**Lilly Maple 2029 / 5'11 / SF / East Central / Indiana Pride**

We have seen Lilly across multiple settings as a youngster, and she has impressed with her versatility and consistent productivity. She is long with wingspan, is fluid and agile on the move and shows the ability to play around the bucket against frontliners or put together attacks from the wing. She rebounds her area, is active and in the mix on both ends and has a lot of upside and versatility to her game. She should step in immediately at the 4A varsity level and make an impact for the Trojans. She had some really good moments during our views at AIS, including an athletic and physical finish at the buzzer to win one contest for her squad.



**Arianna Rowell 2029 / 5'7 / PG / SB St Jospeh / West Virginia Thunder**

Arianna is a dynamic guard that has a lot of playmaking athletic skill in her backcourt game. She can handle as a primary, is shifty and quick on the attack and shows the ability to get buckets in a variety of ways. She has some length at her size, plays with solid instincts as a lead guard, consistently makes plays and is consistently in the mix on both ends. Arianna has already racked up some college offers before hitting the high school hardwood. She was voted onto the All-Showcase Team by the coaches and evaluators with her outstanding play throughout the event.



**Riley Suarez 2029 / 6'1 / SF / Hamilton Heights / West Virginia Thunder**

Riley has a unique combination of size, agility and skill from the wing. She has a long strong frame, is fluid and athletic on the attack and has a ton of versatility in her game on both ends. She has the size to compete at the basket against forwards, shoots it well from the three-point line and has a solid mid-range game. She already has D1 offers before her first high school contest and had a nice showing at the event that included games of 22 and 16 points. She was voted onto the All-Showcase Team by the coaches and evaluators.
