Prospects from throughout the state attended the 9th annual IGBRR Indiana Preseason Prospect Camp to kick off the upcoming high school season. The participants took part in drills, skill competitions, and 5v5 open runs throughout the event. Two prospects won their respective competition contests, which included the 3-point contest, and Hot Shot competition. Ten participants of the camp were selected by the event coaching staff to the All-Camp Team. The following are fifty evaluations from camp participants along review of the days activities.

Millie Allison 2029 / 5'6 / CG / Mooresville

Mille was a participant in our AIS Showcase in early August where she was one of a handful of freshmen to participate in the event and showed she belonged among the elite prospects in her class. She has an evolved backcourt skillset as a frosh, high bball IQ, and is fluid and athletic on the attack. Strong frame for her age, scores the ball in a variety of ways and can lead from the point. Expect she will have an impact for the Pioneers pretty quickly in her career at Mooresville

Simar Athwal 2029 / 5'6 / CG / Franklin Central

We had noticed Simar play a few times over the summer and once again thought she had a nice showing at Prospect Camp. She is a solid athlete with a balanced backcourt skillset and plays with a nice motor. She was aggressive and confident on the attack while showing the ability to make plays going to the bucket. FC will be loaded in the backcourt this year but a great opportunity to develop with and against top level talent in the next few years.

Taylor Babington 2027 / 5'10 / SF / Cathedral

We have been familiar with Taylor for a while now and she has the tools to be a breakout player in the class and she certainly showed flashes of that throughout camp. She has a nice strong frame with length, is athletic on the attack to the bucket and is comfortable with the ball from the perimeter and can knock down the jumper. She was named to the All-Camp team by coaches with her performance throughout the event. I would expect big things from the athletic wing this season at Cathedral.

Jillian Baderstadt 2028 / 6'2 / C / Lake Central

We were able to see Jillian several times over the club season, and she has emerged as one the top post prospects in the class with her size and mobility. She has a big strong post frame, uses it well to be a physical presence on both ends in the paint. Pair that with her agility and footwork at the bucket and she provides a big impact on the frontline. She runs the floor well, rebounds her area, holds her spot on post ups and has nice touch at the basket. While up and down scrimmage runs aren't always the most conducive format for post players to shine she stayed productive throughout the day staying active, rebounding and being efficient at the basket.

Gabrielle Bellamy 2029 / 5'9 / SF / Pike

Lets start by saying that Pike is loaded with talent and this freshman class that Gabrielle is a part of is a special one. She is a big-time athlete with length and wingspan. She is quick and shifty with the ball on the attack and can create opportunities going to the rim with her length and athleticism. She is disruptive on defense, can rebound the ball against forwards, and displays a lot of versatility on both ends. As her skillset continues to progress and paired with her physical tools she has the potential of being a high-level prospect in the class.

Madelyn Bender 2028 / 5'6 / SG / Evansville Central

Madelyn is a solid backcourt prospect that showed a nice balance in her game. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, has nice feel for the action and makes plays on both ends with her energetic play. She got some varsity minutes as a frosh, was JV offensive MVP, and would expect that her role will continue to grow for the Bears in her sophomore season

Libby Berg 2029 / 5'10 / PF / Bishop Chatard

Saw Libby a few different times over the summer playing club ball and again during showcase/camps in the last month and she is certainly a gym rat and appreciate the passion she plays with. She has a strong physical forward frame, does a nice job of defending around the basket, rebounds her area while doing a good job of using her size to control her space. She is comfortable with the ball, can knock down the jumper and shows good feet and touch at the bucket. I expect she will be a contributor for the Trojans sooner rather than later.

Addison Blum 2029/ 5'8 / SG / Hamilton Heights

We have seen a lot of Addison over the last six months, and she is a young prospect in the freshman class to note with her skill and instincts. She has a strong guard frame for her age, has a nice feel for the action on both ends and is a high-level shooter out to the three-point line with range. She is a part of a talented youth movement at Hamilton Heights that will be a fun squad to watch develop over the next four years.

Payton Brodnik 2029 / 5'6 / CG / Brownsburg

Payton has a nice combination of skill, athleticism and motor and that has made her stand out in about every view we have had. She has solid backcourt skillset, is quick and agile on the attack and shows the ability to create shots in a variety of ways. She gets after it on both ends and is consistently in the play and active. As she continues to get stronger she has a solid foundation to be a very productive player in the class and one to keep and eye on in the coming years.

Olivia Brown 2027 / 5'9 / SG / North Harrison

Olivia has a couple years of varsity basketball experience under her belt already which included a solid sophomore campaign. She has a nice combination of size, with some length, and a backcourt skillset. She can handle the ball as needed, has some physicality to her game on both ends and shows the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways. Shoots it well out to the three-point line, can put together a physical straight line drive and shows some nice versatility. She was named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches for her productive play throughout camp. Would expect she is poised for a big junior season for North Harrison.

Ainsley Brown 2027 / 5'7 / CG / Roncalli

Ainsley has been a big-time producer at Scecina her first two seasons but has moved her talents to the Royals lineup at Roncalli. The athletic lefty guard displays the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways with good instincts for the action on both ends. She can handle the ball as needed, is a capable shooter out to the three point line and has playmaking ability. She will be a big addition to a solid Roncalli roster.

Melia Cartwright 2028 / 5'7/ SG / Shelbyville

Melia was a leading producer on the Golden Bear JV squad a year ago as a frosh and would expect her role to continue to grow as a varsity contributor this year. She has some length, is a solid athlete that is agile and fluid on the move. Plays with good energy, has some versatility and shows the skillset to score the ball consistently. She can rebound her area, defends a few spots with her length and stays active on both ends.

Charlotte Caviness 2027 / 5'6 / PG / Rushville

Hard to believe Charlotte is just a junior, seems like she has been coming to our camps the last ten years. She is a solid lead guard that can handle against pressure, initiate offense and makes plays on both ends with skill, instincts, and athleticism. Thought she had a very good day, especially creating space for herself and teammates and consistently hitting the mid-range jumpers. Nice combination of skill, poise and athleticism from the backcourt.

Lillian Clark 2029 / 5'7 / CG / Westfield

We saw Lillian a few times over the club season and noted her play but she has been lights out over the showcase/club season in our views. She has a smooth athletic game with the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways. She shoots it well from deep and can put together athletic attacks to the bucket. She has some length that serves her well on both ends and plays with confidence and poise beyond her years. Part of a solid frosh class at Westfield that should contribute immediately. She was runner-up in the three-point contest and was voted to the All-Camp Team by the coaches.

Morgan Croff 2029 / 5'10 / SG / Kouts

Happen to catch Morgan at another showcase earlier in the month and really liked her upside with her length and agility. She is long with wingspan, shows as a solid athlete with a versatile backcourt skillset. She has a lot of the tools early on to be a promising prospect in the freshman class. She had a really productive day at the event and was noted by several of the coaches and evaluators. I would expect she will be part of Kouts rotation early on.

Zoey Curry 2029 / 5'10 / PF / Hamilton Heights

Zoey is another freshman prospect that we have seen a lot of over the club season this summer. She is part of a very talented freshman Husky class that will make an immediate impact at Hamilton Heights. She has a strong wing frame, versatile length, plays with good instincts and shows ability to knock down open jumpers. Played in both AIS and PPC and was productive in both against her older peers.

Jessica Czarnecki 2028 / 6'0 / PF / Floyd Central

Jessica is long with wingspan and pairs that with nice mobility. She is comfortable with the ball from the wing, can take the open jumper and has the size to operate around the basket against frontliners. She will rebound her area and has versatility on the defensive end with her physical tools. As her skillset continues to progress, she has nice physical tools that will make her a prospect to keep an eye on.

Grace Detweiler 2027 / 5'8 / CG / South Knox

Grace, who was a starter for the 2A South Knox state champion, is a versatile prospect that has a good deal of athleticism in her game. She has some length, is fluid and agile on both ends with the ability to defend several spots. She is a solid shooter out to the three-point line, is comfortable with the ball on the perimeter, and can make plays going to the bucket. She had a solid showing at camp throughout. Look for her role to increase even more her junior season.

Ava Emberton 2029 / 5'6 / CG / Brownsburg

We have seen Ava a lot over the last few months and really enjoy the intensity and consistent motor she plays with. A skilled backcourt prospect that can handle the ball as needed, has high level instincts for the action and has some physicality to her game despite her smaller size. She shoots it well from deep, plays with good pace and has playmaking ability on both ends. She was named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches with an outstanding showing in the event

Nicole Glassley 2028 / 5'8 / SG / Mt Vernon

Nicole can put to the ball in the bucket at a high level. She has elite level shooting ability from deep with range, can put together skilled attacks, and stays confident and aggressive on the offensive end. She saw some varsity minutes a year ago at 4A Pendleton Heights but will be part of a talented backcourt this coming season at Mt Vernon. As she continues to add strength, her game will continue to progress. She was named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches.

Gina Grote 2027 / 5'6 / CG / Oldenburg Academy

If there was a camp MVP Gina would have been in the conversation. She was productive in all areas throughout the event. She is a solid athlete, that has a strong guard frame and has a high motor physical game from the point. She has a good feel for the action, is a playmaker on both ends and can get buckets in a variety of ways. She was the Three Point Skills champion with a record tying 22/30 performance. She was also named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches for her outstanding showing in the event.

Kinsley Hollowell 2029 / 5'6 / CG / Salem

We have seen Kinsley several times at camps over the years and on the club circuit as well. She has a strong guard frame, plays with a nice motor, and has some physicality to her game. Solid jump shooter, can get downhill on straight line drives and makes good decisions with the ball. She won the Hot Shot Skills championship, which was her second in that event. She had an overall solid day and would expect she will make a contribution at the varsity level fairly quickly.

Camille Hurt 2029 / 5'4 / CG / Lawrence North

Was not overly familiar with Camille but she caught our attention pretty quickly with her athletic physical play from the backcourt. She was on the attack throughout the event showcasing her quickness and athleticism going to the bucket. She can handle the ball as needed, mixes it up well and showed the ability to create her own shots. She played with a good motor, has a strong frame for her sizes and plays with confidence. Look forward seeing more of her game this winter.

Madelyn Jones 2027 / 5'4 / PG / Floyd Central

Maddie is a solid backcourt prospect that can handle the ball as needed, shows a nice feel for the game and makes good decisions with the ball. She shoots it well out to the three-point line with a nice stroke, can put together a straight line drive and get to the bucket and stays active and productive on both ends. She spent her first two seasons at Corydon Central but has moved to Floyd Central for her junior season.

Kaylin Kathmann 2027 / 5'8 / CG / Batesville

Kaylin is an intriguing prospect in the 27' class with her athletic backcourt play. She is long, fluid and agile on the attack and has playmaking ability on both ends. She is quick and shifty with the ball, can handle as primary and her skillset has continued to evolve. Probably a bit under the radar right now given her combination of athleticism, length and skill. She has a solid showing at camp and was noted by several coaches.

Nadia Khan 2028 / 5' 9 / CG / Zionsville

Nadia has a strong frame, is a solid athlete and as noted over the summer we really like her versatility. She is comfortable playing from the backcourt and has the strength, size and physicality to take on forwards as well. She can go rebound the ball, defends several different spots and stays consistently active on both ends. Expect her role to continue to grow for the Eagles going into her sophomore season.

Iyla Kress 2029 / 5'9 / PG / Heritage Hills

We saw Iyla a few times in July and noted her athletic play but after camp she has soared up our freshman prospect watchlist. Not only was she one the standout frosh at camp but she had one of the best days of any prospect. She is long, fluid and has high level athleticism in her game. She consistently cut her way to the bucket and was skillful and agile in her finishes. She is comfortable handling the ball and showed she could score the ball in a variety of ways. She has all the tools be a big time prospect in the class. She was named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches for her standout play.

Charli Marcum 2027 / 5'10 / CG / Rushville

Charli has nice size with a strong frame and has some versatility in her game. She is comfortable with the ball from the perimeter, can hit the open jumper and has the size to compete against forwards at the basket. She rebounds her area, can defend a few different positions and has continued to progress her skillset. She had a solid day at camp in our views and expect to see her role to continue to grow for the Lions.

Avalee McNeil 2029 / 5'8 / SF /Center Grove

Avalee has nice size with a strong frame and backcourt skillset that gives her a versatile game on both ends. She shows a good feel for the action, can shoot the ball, is comfortable handling it as needed and is active and physical in her play. Nice combination of size and skill and one to keep an eye on in the coming years for the Trojans.

Makayla Minnis 2029 / 5'5 / PG / Randolph Southern

Our first look at Makayla and she showed the ability to shoot the ball from deep, is comfortable handling it and stays active and engaged on both ends. As she continues to add strength I would expect she will have an impact for the Rebels pretty early on in her high school career.

Lola Morelli 2028 / 5'8 / SG / Roncalli

Very familiar with Lola from previous camps and other play and she is a solid athlete with a strong frame with a good deal of versatility in her game. She is a competitor that can battle against bigger forwards or has the agility to match up against guards. Her skillset has continued to improve and she stays active and productive on both ends of the floor. She played varsity minutes as a frosh and her role showed continue to grow this season for the Royals.

Ava Mount 2028 / 5'8 / SG / Lebanon

We have seen Ava in the gym a lot over the last six months, and it seems she is putting in the time and its showing as her skillset continues to advance against high level competition. She is a nice athlete, handles the ball as needed, can create shots at all levels and shows a good feel for the game. She got some varsity minutes as a frosh and would expect that her role could increase considerably this fall for the Tigers

Jade Mount 2026 / 5'10 / PF / Lebanon

Jade has a big strong frontline frame, shows nice mobility, along with good hands and feet. She has nice touch at the basket, can hit the 10' jumper and does a good job of using her frame to create space on finishes. She rebounds her area, can defend with strength and mobility and is consistent in her approach. She was a starter for the Tigers a year ago and will be leaned on heavily her senior season.

Kendall Patterson 2028 / 5'6 / PG / Northeastern

Seen Kendall a few times over the club season as well and she consistently plays with a good motor, stays active on both ends and makes plays with a blue-collar approach. She can handle the ball as needed, is a capable jump shooter and shows balance in her game. Overall, solid athlete with a good feel for the action and growing backcourt skillset.

Brynn Robinson 2029 / 5'6 / SG / Silver Creek

Seen Brynn a couple times prior in other events and she has a solid backcourt skillset to build on. She can handle the rock on the move, shows the ability to shoot the ball and make plays going to the bucket. Strong frame, aggressive confident play from the guard spot. She is in program at Silver Creek that has some talented guards that should accelerate her development.

Kaydence Rogalski 2028 / 5'6 / SG / Crown Point

Kaydence is a solid athlete, plays with a good motor and physicality from the backcourt. She can handle the ball as needed, gets downhill on straight line drives and is a capable jump shooter. She gets after it on the defensive end and will go mix it up and grab a board from the guard spot. Capable playmaker with her physical tools as her skillset continues progress.

Natalie Schlueter 2028 / 5'9 / SF / Crown Point

Natalie has some wiry length, moves well showing agility and solid athletic play on both ends. She is comfortable with the ball from the perimeter, can hit the mid-range jumper and plays with nice energy. As she continues to add strength and her skillset continues to progress, she has a solid base foundation from the wing to work from.

Maci Senn 2029 / 5'9 / SF / Floyd Central

We have seen Maci a few times over the summer, and she is a solid wing prospect to keep an eye on as her skillset continues to progress. She has some athletic length, moves well, and consistently competes on both ends of the floor. Comfortable with the ball from the perimeter, agile going to the bucket and capable mid-range jump shooter. Can be disruptive on D and makes plays with her length.

Jaylee Slone 2028 / 6'0 / SF / Central Noble

Thought Jaylee had an outstanding day at camp and was noted by several coaches for her play. She is extremely long with wingspan, fluid and agile on the attack and showed the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways. She rebounded her area, was disruptive with her length on the defensive end and showed a lot of versatility on both ends. She definitely played herself on to our 2028 watchlist fall update.

Elyse Snively 2028 / 5'8 / PG / Heritage Christian

We noted Elyse a few times over the summer for her skilled athletic play and thought she had as an impressive day at Prospect camp as any player. She has nice size, strong guard frame and is very skilled from the backcourt. She can handle as a primary, is fluid and athletic on the attack and can knock down the open jumper. Plays with good instincts and is consistently active and productive on both ends. She was named to the All-Camp Team by the coaches. She will have an immediate impact at Heritage Christian this season.

Ellington Sparkman 2028 / 5'4 / SG / DeKalb

Ellington showed solid athletic play from the backcourt. Displayed quick downhill attacks, can knock down the jumper, and sees the floor well while on the move. She plays with a nice motor, is an active defender, and has playmaking abilities with good instincts for the action.

Maren Stevens 2028 / 5'10 / PF / Tri

Maren has a strong forward frame with good length. She moves well and shows agility around the basket. She rebounds her area and has some versatility on defense with her size and mobility. As she continues to progress her offensive skillset, she has some nice tools to be a productive forward for the Titans.

Kinley Teipen 2028 / 5'7 / SF / Avon

Kinley has a strong frame, stays active on both ends and doesn't mind mixing it up. Lefty that finds space on the offensive end and is shot ready on the catch or comfortable handling the ball and making straight line drives from the wing. She shows some versatility on the defensive end and will go chase down boards and loose balls.

Kiersten Thompson 2029 / 5'8 / CG / Silver Creek

Wasn't surprised that Kiersten shined throughout the camp. We had seen her several times over the club season and had noted her skilled athletic play. She has some length, is fluid on the attack, shows the ability to score the ball in a variety of ways. Smooth instinctual play with a good deal of versatility. As she continues to add strength to her frame she will be a prospect to keep an eye on. Even as skilled as Silver Creek will be this year I would not be surprised if she finds herself in the varsity rotation as a frosh.

Annie Vermillion 2029 / 5'7 / SG / Cascade

Our first look at Annie and she came in and competed hard and mixed it up on both ends. She has some length for her size, is a solid athlete and flashed the ability to make plays at times. She is comfortable handling the ball as needed, capable jump shooter and can get downhill on her drives. As she continues to polish her skillset and get reps at the high school level, she has the base to round into a productive prospect for the Cadets.

Eva Walker 2029 / 5'6 / PG / La Porte

Eva can handle as primary, shows nice court vision while on the attack and displayed the ability to make good decisions with the ball in the up and down action of the open runs. She can knock down the open jumper when in rhythm, plays with a solid motor and has nice instincts as a lead guard. As she continues to add strength and develops with high school reps she has a solid backcourt foundation as a frosh.

Citrus Wesley 2029 / 5'4 / PG / Fountain Central

Our first extended look at Citrus and she displayed high motor athletic play throughout the event. She can handle as a primary, is aggressive on the attack and was able to put pressure on her matchup on both ends with her athleticism. I'm not real familiar with what Fountain Central brings back this year but expect someone with Citrus's athleticism could find her way into the rotation pretty quickly.

Isabella Wroblewski 2026 / 5'9 / SF / Penn

Bella has strong wing frame, tough nosed kid that makes good decisions on the court. Shows the ability to knock down open jumpers, has some physicality on straight line drives and stays active on both ends. She can go compete for boards against frontliners with her size and strength, competes on D, and shows overall good instincts for the game. She was productive and consistent throughout camp.

Kylie Wyatt 2029 / 5'9 / SG / Westfield

We have seen Kylie in several events over the last month, and she has been consistently productive across those views. She has some length, displays nice athletic play on both ends with a solid backcourt skillset. She can shoot the ball out to the three-point line with range, has the skill and strength to attack the bucket from the wing and can handle the ball as needed. She plays with a solid motor, has some physicality to her game and plays with solid instincts. Several coaches noted her play throughout the camp.
