



2026 IGBRR All-Indiana Showcase

One hundred of Indiana's top girls high school basketball prospects participated in the 12th annual IGBRR All-Indiana Showcase on Sunday August 9th at Triton Central High School. The showcase included players from all four high school classes 2027-30' and the participant list can be found online. The underclass included top prospects within their respective classes. The 2027 senior class included uncommitted prospects that played in front of NAIA/D3 college coaches that were recruiting them.

The event started with ninety minutes of station work. The participants rotated between four skill stations. The next three hours of the event included three rounds of forty-eight-minute running clock games. The showcase teams were coached by some of the top trainers in Indiana. The event concluded with the naming of the All-Indiana Showcase Team as voted by the event's coaches and evaluators. 2027 AIS Class

A look at all fifteen of the 2027 senior prospects from the All-Indiana Showcase on August 9th at Triton Central High School.



Taylor Babington 2027 / 5'11 / SF / Cathedral

Taylor has a lot of intriguing qualities with her length and athleticism. She has attended a few of our camps and has always shown well with the up and down high tempo flow of showcase play. She is comfortable with the ball from the wing but really excels getting downhill on her attacks and creating shots going to the bucket with her athleticism. She has the physical tools to rebound against frontliners and the agility and size to defend several spots. Would expect her role and productivity to continue to grow as she enters into her senior season with the Irish this winter.

Ainsley Brown 2027 / 5'7 / CG / Roncalli

Ainsley was part of the rotation for the 3A state runner-up Royals last winter. After starring at Scecina for her first two years she transferred to Roncalli and would expect an expanded role for the senior guard this coming season. She shows nice athletic play on both ends of the floor, has a strong guard frame, can handle the ball as needed and shows nice balance between her jumpers and attacks. Overall, solid instincts for the game, stays active with the skillset and athleticism to make plays from the backcourt.

Emma Clark 2027 / 5'9 / SF / Fishers

Emma has nice length to her frame and is a solid athlete that gives her a good deal of versatility on both ends of the floor. She embraces the ability to play and defend multiple spots and seen game play where she may be battling against forwards at the basket and others where she is playing more from the backcourt and wing engaging with guards. She shoots the ball well out to the three-point line, is a tough-nosed competitor on both ends and plays with nice energy. She has continued to expand her skillset over the course of our views the last three years and has the flexibility and versatility to find her "role" in different settings.

Hailey Conder 2027 / 5'4 / CG / South Central (Elizabeth)

Hailey has established herself as one the top shooters in the class, and despite her smaller size has consistently shown she is more than a "shooter" and can get buckets in a variety of ways from all three levels. Throw in her high IQ play, where she can be trusted to make the right read/decisions with her energetic play and she seems to always be productive in our views. It didn't take long for coaches to recognize her as one the premiere shooters in the gym during drill stations where prospects were getting up hundreds of shots in the opening ninety minutes.

Grace Deaton 2027 / 5'6 / SG / Cascade

Grace is entering her fourth year of varsity play and brings a ton of productive experience to the court. She has transferred to Cascade for her senior season where she will be an immediate impact player for the Cadets. She has a balanced backcourt game with the ability to shoot the ball from the three-point line and has an athletic skilled game attacking the basket where she gets herself to the free throw line at a good clip. She can handle the ball as needed, stays active on both ends and plays with good instincts for the game. Overall, well-rounded productive guard play.

Grace Detweiler 2027 / 5'9 / SF / South Knox

Grace has been a big part of a very successful South Knox program over the last couple seasons. She has nice versatility in her game with her combination of length, athleticism and solid skill from the perimeter. Shoots it well in the mid-range, extends to the three-point line and can make skilled athletic attacks to the basket. She is capable of grabbing boards from the guard spot and is a tough nosed high effort defender. Has had to share the ball a lot with talented teammates but can score it as needed and stays productive without having to have the ball and volume shots. Solid well-rounded game with nice versatility.

Audrina Dugan 2027 / 5'9 / SG / East Central

We have noted Audrina several times over the last couple years and have always loved her motor and how consistently hard she plays on both ends of the floor. Add in that she has nice length to her strong guard frame and is deceptively athletic and she has some qualities that will translate well to the next level. She has been increasingly productive in her 4A high school career and shown well in multiple showcases events against high level competition. A capable shooter out to the three-point line, athletic and aggressive to the bucket, and will mix it up with physical high energy play on both ends. A bit under the radar senior prospect that could end up as steal at the right small college.

Arianna Harrington 2027 / 5'7 / CG / Fishers

Arianna is an elite athlete with a high-level backcourt skillset and that was on display throughout the event Sunday. She is quick and athletic with the ball on the attack and excels in the open court and the fast paced up and down tempo of the showcase games. She can handle the ball as needed, is a capable jump shooter but at her best putting pressure on the D with her athleticism and physical attacks from the backcourt. She repeatedly showed the ability to create her own shots and get buckets in a variety of ways. She has transferred to Fishers for her senior season and will be an immediate impact player for the Tigers

Addisyn King 2027 / 6'0 / PF / Franklin

We have liked Addisyn as a frontline prospect in the 27' class for a while. She missed some time with an injury but has shown herself to be productive since her return last high school season and this spring/summer in club ball play. She has a strong forward frame, moves well in tight spaces with good hands and feet at the basket, strong face up game with the ability to attack out of the mid-post. Displays agility and touch in her offensive game and extends to the three-point line with a nice lefty jumper. She rebounds her area and is a solid defender with her size and mobility. A bit of an under the radar forward with nice combination of size, agility and skill.

Kihanna Mellanson 2027 / 5'4 / PG / Heritage Christian

As mentioned during the announcement of the All-Showcase team there was no other prospect Sunday that was talked about by the staff and coaches more than Kihanna. She had herself a day, while we had seen her several times over the winter after transferring into Heritage Christian from Texas last year, we had not seen her shoot and score the ball like she did at the showcase. She is a true lead guard that is crafty and athletic on the attack, sees the floor well on the move, and has a nice feel for the game controlling the pace and setting the table. Her ability to knock down the three in bunches and light up the scoreboard at the event elevated her game to whole different level in these views. Look forward to seeing more of that scoring punch this coming winter for the Eagles. She was the only senior named to the All-Showcase team by the coaches

Marissa Pleasant 2027 / 5'9 / SG / Marquette Catholic

Saw Marissa a couple times during July play and she impressed, so we were glad to have her in the gym for AIS. She is standout athlete, has a strong guard frame, and a skilled backcourt game. Pair that with her motor and competitive spirit and she brings productivity and tenacity to the court. She is known for her ability to shoot the three, but her proficiencies are much deeper with the ability to handle the ball when needed and creates shots in a variety of ways with her athleticism. Strong on ball defender that plays with solid instincts for the action. A lot of upside at the next level as an "athlete".

Kendal Price 2027 / 5'7 / PG / Mooresville

Kendal is a steady and dependable lead guard that has a balanced backcourt skillset and has continued to add to her game over the last couple years. She does a good job of controlling pace, making the correct read and playing with a nice feel for the action. She sees the floor well on the attack, capable jumper out to three-point line and is crafty on her way to the bucket. She is active and brings a lot of energy to the defensive end as a reliable on the ball and help side defender. Productive two-way player that brings instincts, skill and motor from the guard spot.

McKenzi Rutland 2027 / 5'11 / PF / North Central

McKenzie had an extremely productive spring/summer in our views, and she has a great balance between physicality and finesse in her frontcourt game. She has strong forward frame and can muscle her way around the paint against other post while also showing nice hands/feet and agility at the forward spot. At the same time, she is comfortable with the ball away from the basket, a capable jump shooter from the mid-range and can put together athletic attacks from the mid-post. She rebounds her area and has the size and mobility to be an active defender on the frontline.

Delaney Wilson 2027 / 5'5 / SG / Fishers

Delaney got regular varsity minutes last year as a junior for the Tigers and would expect her role will continue to grow this season. She is a feisty athletic guard that can handle and initiate offense or play off the ball. She is a capable jump shooter out to the three-point line where she is shot ready and has a quick release. She has continued to grow her skillset over the last three years and plays with solid instincts from the backcourt and nice motor on both ends.

2028 AIS Class

A look at ten of the 2028 junior prospects from the All-Indiana Showcase on August 9th at Triton Central High School.



Jillian Baderstadt 2028 / 6'2 / C / Lake Central

Jillian had a really nice day as one of the most consistently productive post prospects throughout the event. She has a big strong frontline frame, played with good energy and owned her area around the basket. Up and down showcase play is not always a conducive setting for post players, but she was efficient and productive, aggressive to the boards and did a nice job of running the floor between the lane lines. Coaches noted her post play and named her to the All-Showcase team as only one of two 2028 prospects and the only center.

Rylie Johnson 2028 / 5'10 / SG / Yorktown

We have liked Rylie's upside for quite some time and noted her earlier this summer during club play. She is long with wingspan, a solid athlete with a backcourt skillset. The combination of her physical tools and ball skills make her a versatile prospect. She can handle the ball as needed, puts together athletic attacks from the perimeter or in transition where she makes plays going to the basket with her agility and length and knocks down the jumper out to the three-point line. As she has continued to add strength to her frame her game on both ends has continued to blossom.

Kyla Kjendalen 2028 / 5'8 / SG / Dekalb

We ran into Kyla early this spring for the first time, noted her play and have added her to our top 100 watchlist in the class. Got to see her a few more times over the summer but thought she significantly helped her stock at AIS with a really productive showing. She has a strong guard frame, shows as a solid athlete in her play, and has a balanced game from the backcourt. She is aggressive, athletic and fluid in her attacks and has an efficient mid-range game with the ability to hit the three as well. She rebounds it from the guard spot, shows athletic physicality on both ends with instinctual play. A junior prospect that has the tools to race up the class watchlist over the next two years.

Hillary Labis 2028 / 5'11 / SG / Westville

Hillary is a top of the class prospect that holds several offers already and that showed in her play at AIS. She has a long strong frame, plays with high level instincts and is one of the top shooters in the class. She can get buckets in a variety of ways with her versatile play, has nice feel and touch on her way to the rim, and takes on contact and gets to the line repeatedly. She can rebound against forwards with her size and can be disruptive with her length defensively. She was named to the All-Showcase team by the event coaches.

Carlee Lanzer 2028 / CG / 5'9 / New Castle

We have liked Carlee's upside as an athletic playmaking guard since we saw her in her freshman season. She can handle as a lead if needed, is active off the ball and shows the ability to score it in variety of ways. She is at her best using her athleticism to attack the basket where she has playmaking ability and gets to the free throw line but has also continued to improve as a jump shooter. She was recovering from injury most of this spring but nice to see her back at it over the summer and AIS with a solid productive showing.

Katharine Lehr 2028 / 5'7 / PG / Bloomington South

Kate is one of the top true PG in the class and always seems to be so consistent and productive in our views. High level instincts for the game, as you would expect, and athletic playmaking skillset with a mature trusted approach. Shows balance with nice court vision on the attack, creates space and opportunity for herself and teammates, and can score the ball as needed. Has proven herself against elite talent as a two-year 4A starter in high school, high level club and showcase play. Has transferred to cross town rival South for her junior season.

Madelynn Matelic 2028 / 6'0 / SF / Plainfield

Madelynn previously starred at Speedway her first two high school seasons but has transferred to 4A Plainfield entering her junior year. She is long, a solid athlete, with a versatile skillset. She is a very intriguing prospect with her length and skill from the wing. Those wing skills have continued to improve in our views over the last two years, she is continuing to become more fluid in her finishes and as she adds strength to her frame her game is blossoming. She is comfortable handling the ball in the open court and on the attack, is a capable jump shooter and can create shots at all levels with her length and athleticism. It will be interesting to see how her role develops for the Quakers this season.

Saylor Schleicher 2028 / 5'7 / SG / Silver Creek

Thought Saylor had an outstanding showing at AIS, consistently displayed confident skilled play in both drills and game play while averaging 15.6 PPG across three games. She was part of the rotation at 1A Borden that won back-back state championships and has now transferred to 3A powerhouse Silver Creek. She is comfortable handling the ball, has good instincts and feel for the action, and is known for her ability to shoot the ball from the three-point line. She has some length to her guard frame, has continued to get physically stronger, and has a poised mature approach about her backcourt game. Overall, a balanced, skilled guard that will make an immediate impact for the Dragons.

Amaya St.Hilaire 2028 / 6'3 / PF / West Lafayette

Haven't had as many extended views of Amaya as some of the other top prospects in the class, so it was nice to have her into AIS for the day. She quickly reminds you why she is considered among the top frontline prospects in the class. She is extremely long, with wingspan, and is agile and athletic in her play around the basket showing some tremendous physical tools. Her hands/feet and post skills continue to improve as well as her confidence on the attack, she averaged 19.5 PPG across a couple games. She rebounds her area at high level with her length and reach and is a defensive presence in the paint with her size and mobility.

Jada Walker 2028 / 5'2 / PG / Northridge

Jada is always a fun watch with her high motor fearless play from the lead guard spot. She is a confident ball handler, is crafty and athletic on the attack showing balance between setting up teammates and finding her shots. Despite her smaller side she doesn't back down and consistently makes plays on both ends with her energy, athleticism, and competitive spirit. Whether it was drills stations or game play the coaches repeatedly noted her energy and hard-nosed play throughout the event.

2029 AIS Class

A look at sixteen of the 2029 sophomore prospects from the All-Indiana Showcase on August 9th at Triton Central High School.



Ella Boyanski 2029 / 5'9 / CG / Chesterton

Ella was an invite at AIS as a frosh last year and not surprisingly went on to have a very productive freshman season for 4A Chesterton over the winter averaging double figures. She did not play club in the spring, so it was nice to get her in the gym for the showcase. She was impressive with her combination of length, athleticism and backcourt skill that gives her nice versatility on both ends of the floor. She can handle as needed, is a matchup issue with her long strong frame, agility and playmaking tools. She was only one of four players to put up multiple 20+ point games. After not seeing her live for nearly a year she came into AIS and re-confirmed that she is a high potential prospect in the class that we currently have in our top 30 class watchlist.

Lillian Clark 2029 / 5'9 / SG / Westfield

After having tremendous showing at Futures and Prospect camps last year, Lillian had a monster breakout season for the Rock's in her freshman season and she went on to play high level EYBL club ball this spring/summer as well. She has nice length to her frame, is athletic in all aspects of her game and is one of the top bucket getters in the class. She can score it at all levels in a variety of ways, create her own shots and has a smooth confident approach with her offensive toolset. The top 10 (2029) sophomore prospect was named to the AIS All-Showcase team by the coaches.

Lilly Coleman 2029 / 6'2 / C / Danville

We saw Lilly several times over the club season and noted her play. She has a big strong post frame and does a nice job of owning her area with the ability to bury her opponents on the block. She has soft hands, nice feet, and solid touch around the basket. She will even step out and shoot the three where she hit a few Sunday. She rebounds her area with her size and reach and has the mobility defensively to rotate and help protect the paint. The top 50 (2029) sophomore prospect was among the most productive frontliner prospects at the showcase.

Ava Emberton 2029 / 5'7 / CG / Brownsburg

Ava was the talk of the showcase with her athletic skilled high motor play from start to finish. She led all scorers with three 20+ point games, including a showcase high 34-point performance. She repeatedly got to the basket showing a crafty handle, quick step and skilled backcourt play. Overall, balance between her attack and jumpers while also displaying nice instincts and court vision while on the move. We have really liked Ava in our views over the last year, always plays with big energy, and she is ranked in our top 40 prospects in the class but her performance at AIS was a whole different level. She was unanimously named to the AIS All-Showcase team.

Malyiah Evans 2029 / 6'0 / SG / North Central

Malyiah already has several D1 offers going into her sophomore season as one of the most versatile prospects in the class. She is long, has wingspan, is athletic and fluid in all aspects of her game. She can get buckets at all levels and is a tough matchup with her combination of length, athleticism and backcourt skills, as she showed with a 28-point AIS game. She can grab boards against forwards and is disruptive on the defensive end with her length and agility. She was part of the varsity rotation at 4A Pike last year and transferred to North Central this season where she should have a breakout season for the Panthers. She was voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the coaches and currently is the IGBRR #6 prospect in the class.

Journey Frederick 2029 / 5'7 / PG / Franklin

Our first extended view of Journey was at PGH showcase last fall and was able to see her several more times over the winter where she was part of the Franklin varsity rotation as a frosh. We again noted her this spring in club ball. Her athleticism on both ends jumps out at you, she handles the ball as a lead and is shifty and explosive on the move while mixing it up well between her jumpers and attacks. Plays with poise, confidence and solid instincts. As she continues to get stronger, she has a good deal of upside as an athletic playmaking guard in the class.

Harvest Green 2029 / 5'9 / SG / Bishop Luers

Harvest has a strong guard frame, shows nice athleticism in all parts of her game and is confident and skilled with the ball. She is physical on the attack and is agile and athletic finisher that gets to the free throw line, also a capable shooter out to the three-point line with the ability to create space and shots. Rebounds from the guard spot and active instinctual defender. She had a big freshman season for Luers averaging nearly 17 PPG and 7.5 RPG, currently ranked as a top 20 prospect in the class.

Mia Hibbard 2029 / 5'10 / SF / ECA

We haven't seen Mia in extended views as much as some of the other top talent but really like her upside and was happy to get her in the gym for the day. She did not disappoint and was very productive throughout the showcase as noted the staff. She has a long strong forward frame mixed with solid backcourt skills. She is comfortable handling the ball from the wing and in the open court, has nice balance between her jumpers and attacks and is rough matchup for most with her size and skill. She can rebound against forwards, is active and versatile on both ends and put up a 25-point performance. A top 40 prospect in the class with plenty of potential for continued growth.

Iyla Kress 2029 / 5'11 / SG / Heritage Hills

Iyla came into prospect camp last fall and just blew us away and she has taken off like a rocket ship ever since. Her high-level athleticism on both ends of the court combined with length and backcourt skills make her a very versatile prospect. A capable shooter out to the three-point line but at her best on the attack using her length and agility to create shots going to the basket. Can go get boards against forwards and can defend several spots with her physical tools. As she continues to add strength to her frame and polish her perimeter skills, she has as much upside as anyone in the class. She was voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the coaches with her consistent productive play. Currently a top 15 prospect in the class, with the tools to make even more noise.

Carlie Kuebler 2029 / 5'9 / SG / Boonville

Saw Carlie putting up big freshman numbers this past winter in the box scores and finally got to see her in early spring club play and several more times since. She has nice length with a strong guard frame, is a solid athlete with a balanced backcourt skillset. She can handle the ball as needed, has a solid mid-range game with a nice stroke that extends to the three-point line and has the strength and agility to make plays and get to the free throw line going to the basket. With the graduation of Parker, she will be leaned on for increased production this coming season and most likely a big sophomore season loading.

Savayah Mitchell 2029 / 5'8 / PG / Pike

Not surprisingly Savayah was one of the top prospects in the gym throughout the event, the sophomore is currently ranked as the #2 prospect in the class. She has nice length, elite level athleticism in all aspects of her game and is one of the top lead guards regardless of class. She is smooth and poised with the ball, a capable shooter out to the three-point line but at her best on the attack using her playmaking athleticism and skill to create shots and get to the free throw line on her way to the bucket. She was the second leading scorer as a frosh on one of the state's top 4A teams and with transfer and injury she will be leaned on even more this coming season. She was voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the event coaches.

Avery Paridaen 2029 / 5'10 / PF / Gibson Southern

We saw Avery a couple times over the winter where she had a productive freshman season for the Titans and again several times this spring/summer in club play. Glad we were able to have her at AIS where she proved herself against the elite in her class and others, which included a 30-point performance. She has a long strong forward frame, is a solid athlete and shows a good deal of versatility in her game. She has some physicality at the basket with nice touch and agility, is comfortable with the ball from the wing and can make athlete attacks out of the mid-post. Rebounds against forwards and can defend a few different spots with her size and mobility. She was voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the event coaches.

Riley Suarez 2029 / 6'2 / SF / Hamilton Heights

Riley has that rare combination of a long strong forward frame, solid athleticism with a backcourt skillset. She can get buckets from all levels in a variety of ways which includes a deadly mid-post turnaround jumper and the ability to stretch it out to the three-point line. She is comfortable handling the ball, is a tough matchup with her size and skill and is quite versatile on both ends. The IGBRR #3 prospect in the class had games of 22 and 21 while being voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the event coaches.

Lillia Tapak 2029 / 5'9 / PG / Center Grove

Lillia took over the reins as the lead guard for 4A powerhouse Trojans as a freshman that ended with a state championship, which says volumes about her game. As expected, she is a high IQ player that is poised and calculated with the ball that can be trusted to make the right read/decision. Balanced between setting up teammates and finding her own shots. Add in her nice length from the guard spot, athleticism, and solid motor and she is as a complete PG in the class as there is. Top 15 IGBRR class prospect that was voted to the AIS All-Showcase team by the event coaches.

Journey Washington 2029 / 5'9 / SG / Franklin Central

Journey carved out a productive role this past season as frosh on a talented veteran Flashes squad. She has nice combination of length, athleticism and backcourt skill this gives her a good deal of versatility on both ends of the floor. Balanced with ability to shoot the jumper and playmaking skills on the attack with the tools to create shoots and score it in a variety of ways. As she continues to polish her backcourt skillset, she has the tools to be a very productive and highly sought after prospect in the class.

McKenzie White 2029 / 6'0 / C / FW Snider

McKenzie has a big strong post frame and combine that with her agility and touch around the bucket, and she is a super productive frontline prospect. She can bury her opponents on the block with her strength, knows how to use her frame to create space and displays skilled play. She rebounds her area with a nose for the ball and stays active and effective on both ends of the floor while playing with nice energy. A top 20 prospect in the class that showed as one of the top post prospects on the day.

2030 AIS Class

A look at eight of the 2030 freshman prospects from the All-Indiana Showcase on August 9th at Triton Central High School.



Brooklyn Bizila 2030 / 6'0 / SF / HSE

Brooklyn was the only frosh that was selected to the All-Showcase team with an extremely productive and consistent showing throughout the day. She both put up one of the top scores of the event with a 24-point effort but also averaged 16.3 PPG across three contests. She has a long strong high school ready frame, is a solid athlete with backcourt skills. She shows the ability to get buckets in a variety of ways, including knocking down the three. She can rebound against forwards and provides a lot of versatility on both ends with her size, agility and skill. Some similarities to just graduated HSE standout Kayla Stidham. Expect to see her in the box score right away for the Royals this winter.

Liv DeFauw 2030 / 5'10 / SG / Penn

Liv had a great showing at our Futures camp last year and once again proved herself against elite competition in an up and down fast paced environment on Sunday. She has nice length, strong guard frame, physicality and instincts to compliment her backcourt skillset. She can handle the ball as needed, is fluid and crafty on the attack and can knock down the three ball in bunches. Penn brings back an experienced and talented core of players but I'm sure with the combination of size and skill from the guard spot Liv will make an impact early on for the Kingsmen.

Tatum Eberly 2030 / 5'5 / PG / Fishers

Tatum is one of the top true PG in the class and plays with skill and maturity beyond her years. She can handle against pressure, sees the floor well on the move and creates space and opportunity for herself and teammates. High level instincts, crafty playmaking skill and can score the ball, as shown with a 20-point game. Reminds you bit of Mt Vernon junior standout point guard Zoey Woods. Balanced dynamic play with the ability to consistently knock down shoots, controls pace/tempo and setup teammates repeatedly. Would expect she will be in the varsity rotation mix from the start for the 4A Tigers.

Journie Johnson 2030 / 5'10 / SG / Carmel

Journie is one of the more dynamic scorers in the class with the ability to get buckets at all levels in a variety of ways. Strong frame, physical athletic game to the basket and can knock down shots out to the three-point line. Skilled playmaking ability and is confident and aggressive in her approach for a youngster. While Carmel is deep in backcourt talent, expect her to still make an impact from day one for the Greyhounds

Adalyn Nicely 2030 / 5'6 / PG / Western Boone

We saw Adalyn several times over the spring/summer and noted her skilled athletic play from the guard spot. She can operate from the point where she is smooth and crafty on the attack, plays with high level instincts and is a solid athlete in all aspects of her game. She was confident and productive throughout the event, including a 24-point effort and averaged 14.6 PPG across three contests. She can create shots at all levels, sees the court well on the move and is balanced and poised in her play from the backcourt. As she continues to add strength to her frame, she has tremendous amount of upside in the class.

Isabella Slate 2030 / 5'10 / SF / Columbus North

We saw Bella a few times during the club season and obviously thought a lot of her game to extend an invite, but she probably exceeded our expectations as much as any frosh at AIS. She is long, fluid, and showed a ton of versatility on both ends of the floor. She scored the ball at high level, including a point 20 game, and played with nice energy and poise on both ends of the floor. North brings back five of their top seven players and some nice depth but would expect Bella to compete for some varsity time this season.

Maddie Smalligan 2030 / 5'10 / PG / HSE

Maddie has as much upside as any player in the class and was one of the most consistent and productive frosh at the showcase. She has nice wiry length from the guard spot, shows high level athleticism and skill in all parts of her game and is aggressive and confident in her approach for a youngster. She can handle as a lead, scores the ball in a variety of ways and is a versatile playmaker with her combination of length, agility and skill. She will be in the Royal's varsity rotation right away which tells you a lot about the incoming freshman's game.

Katelyn Tofani 2030 / 5'8 / CG / Lawrence Central

We have seen a lot of Katelyn over the last year, and she certainly doesn't play or look like an incoming freshman. She has a strong high school ready guard frame, is athletic and versatile in all areas of her game and has instincts and feel for the action beyond her years. She is balanced between her attacks and jumpers, can score it in a variety of ways and has playmaking tools on both ends of the floor. She is poised and confident in her play for a youngster and is consistently efficient and productive in our views. Expect she will be part of the 4A Bears rotation early on.
