One hundred thirty of Indiana's top young prospects participated in the 2026 Indiana Futures Camp on Sunday August 16th at Triton Central High School. The camp consisted of prospects in the 2030, 2031 and 2032 classes and the participation list can be found at IGBRR.COM. The campers were led in instruction throughout the event by several of the state's top trainers and coaches. The camp consisted of drill to skill stations; 5 on 5 half court and full court runs. The camp also featured twenty-four prospects in the Futures 3-point contest, thirty-two in the Futures Hot Shot competition and another sixteen in the Skills Challenge.

Twenty-four of the camp's top shooters participated in the Indiana Futures Camp 3-point contest. 30' Amelia Theising, East Central, would pace the field with seven triples in the first round, as eight shooters would advance to the semi-finals. In the second-round Amelia Theising would once again lead the pack, this time knocking down eight of her ten attempts in advancing to the championship, while 31' Camryn Drone, Rensselaer Central., would hit seven to advance to the finals as well. After four hours of camp the finalist wouldn't quite have their shooting legs in the final round as Camryn Done would come away with the 3-2 victory in championship round. Indiana Futures Hot Shot Champion

Thirty-two of the Futures campers participated in the Hot Shot competition. The participants were given 45 seconds to accumulate points by knocking down shots from various spots worth different point values. 2030 Rylie Paskiewicz, Yorktown, would win the first round with a score of 25 and lead the final eight into the semi-finals. In the second-round Rylie Paskiewicz would once again pace the field with 28 points and secure as spot in the championship, while 31' Natasha Nastav, Crown Point, advanced to the finals with a round of 24. Indiana Futures Skills Challenge Champion 2032 Charlie Ristenpart Crown Point

Sixteen IGBRR Futures campers took on the Skills Challenge course. 32' Charlie Ristenpart, Crown Point, would set the pace in the first round with a time of 16.4. Defending champion 30' Alexa Brisco, Penn, would advance to the championship with the quickest time in the semi-final round and on the day with a 16.0 , while first round winner Charlie Ristenpart, would put up the second quickest result and join her in the finals.
